# treasurer's corner

Thanks to Cynthia and her team of volunteers for organizing another successful event. The Chinese New Year Banquet remains the largest single event that MSBCA has “religiously” hosted. On the forefront, it looks like everything falls into place. However, behind the scene, there is a lot of effort and organization to make it happen.

The Chinese New Year Banquet is also a time where MSBCA pays tribute to its senior member. MSBCA subsidized a portion of the complimentary senior’s tickets. This year, MSBCA decided not hold a Raffles or 50/50 draw against the strict compliance with AGLC rules and regulations. Traditionally, those draws would net MSBCA about \$1,000. That said our net loss for this event is about \$1,000 more than it would have been. MSBCA endeavor to limit losses in our events, balancing affordability and optimizing membership participation.

We look forward to your continued support in our next major event – Cultural Night 2011 at the Chinese Cultural Center on June 4.
