Summary of Minutes of Meeting October 5 2011

Our first committee meeting was held on Wednesday, October 5, 2011 at the clubhouse from 7:00pm to 10:15pm. The meeting was attended by all committee members except VP Singapore who was overseas.

The President assigned committee members their portfolios and administrative duties. Dennis Wong a member of MSBCA was engaged as Project Manager to oversee the maintenance of the clubhouse on a voluntary basis including fire and safety security, clubhouse leakages, kitchen cleaning and such. Tracey Bong has been approved by the Board to renew and continue as MSBCA editor for another term. The Board was informed that the "MSBCA" dance group has been discontinued.

All the VPs have decided to hold its own National Day celebration at the clubhouse for members. The Secretary is required to file the annual return to the Alberta registries once the Auditor's Report is ready and approved at the SGM. Financial Report is to be approved by the general membership in a Special General Meet-

ing. The Association shall operate on the official 1999 Bylaws for the year. Treasurer discussed the need for better administrative structure including checklist for AGLC Report, Annual Report, Assistant for bookkeeping, Rubber Stamp for cheque Deposits, Serialised with logo Rubber Stamp for Receipts, which would help to minimise the monthly bookkeeping workload. Treasurer will be submitting the year's Bank Financial Statement Report to AGLC by October 10, 2011 and other duties to complete include Accounting Report since 2009 to be submitted to AGLC, and MSBCA renewal of Property Tax.

PayPal for membership payment was considered for further discussion by the membership coordinator. Social events for the year were discussed including holding the Halloween Party at the clubhouse on October 29, Xmas Party in December 10, New Year Eve Party on December 31, Chinese New Year Banquet on February 3 2012, a Senior/Youth Night, Social Night and Sunday lunches.

In Sports, the coordinator was asked

by the Board to justify the sponsorship and continuation of Badminton rental for members.

A number of housekeeping issues were discussed which need to be resolved including leaking ceiling roof, kitchen stove and filter cleaning, fire safety rectification and reinspection, no hot water in clubhouse and consideration to change condo management. Consideration of new premises for MSBCA because of high maintenance of the current clubhouse was discussed. Board suggests a feasibility study and to put up a motion to proceed with the new building initiative to the general membership at the Special General Meeting. A call was requested to review Clubhouse rental. A schedule was requested for the Bylaws amendment as well.

The meeting ended at 10:15pm. The next meeting will be held on November 5 2011 at a restaurant to welcome all Board members.

Rental Rates & Terms (with effect 1 May 2006):

Rental Hours: 9 am to midnight

Members (including sound system):

Mon-Fri: \$132

Sat-Sun, Holidays: \$165

Non-members (excluding sound system):

Mon-Fri: \$180

Sat-Sun, Holidays: \$220

An additional \$100 is chargeable for the use of the sound system

Damage Deposit *Mandatory for ALL (refundable if there is no damage or loss to property):

- Building \$100
- Sound system \$400

With immediate effect, there will be a cleaning surcharge of \$50.00 if the clubhouse is not properly cleaned after each rental. If applicable, this will be deducted from the damage deposit.
